

KIRKLEES COUNCIL

(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 23) ORDER 2023

A62 LEEDS ROAD, ST. ANDREW'S ROAD, GASWORKS STREET, AND LOWER FITZWILLIAM STREET, HUDDERSFIELD

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

1. Introduce no right turn restrictions from:

- a) A62 Leeds Road, Huddersfield to Gasworks Street, Huddersfield
- b) A62 Leeds Road, Huddersfield to B6432 St Andrew's Road, Huddersfield
- c) Lower Fitzwilliam Street, Huddersfield to the access road into Great Northern Retail Park, Huddersfield

2. Introduce a no left turn restriction from B6432 St Andrew's Road, Huddersfield to A62 Leeds Road, Huddersfield

AND

3. Revoke items from The Huddersfield (Parts of St. Andrew's Road and Thistle Street) Traffic Regulation Orders 1969, which will be redundant when certain parts of the restrictions referred to above are introduced.

This Order was made on 10 January 2024 and will take effect on 23 January 2024.
