

KIRKLEES COUNCIL
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO. 14) ORDER 2021
NO RIGHT TURN
ZETLAND STREET, HUDDERSFIELD

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of road in the Huddersfield area of the Kirklees district, will be to:

- Introduce a no right turn restriction from Zetland Street, Huddersfield to Queensgate, Huddersfield

REASON:

As part of a major scheme to reduce congestion and improve journey times on Queensgate, Huddersfield a change in turning manoeuvres is needed from Zetland Street on to Queensgate.

In order to make the signalised junction of Queensgate and Zetland Street work more efficiently, the ability to turn right out of the junction is to be removed by introducing a right turn ban. All traffic leaving Zetland Street will now need to turn left.

It is intended these proposals will help reduce congestion on Queensgate, Huddersfield
