Warren Street Dewsbury

NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce a one-way traffic flow for all vehicles on

Warren Street, Savile Town, Dewsbury

from its junction with Headfield Road in a north-easterly direction to its junction with South Street for a distance of 216m; and on

Chapel Street, Savile Town, Dewsbury

from its junction with South Street in a south westerly and south easterley direction to its junction with Warren St for a distance of 99m

REASON: The Order will be implemented initially on an experimental basis for eighteen months, after which time it will be reviewed. The Council may then make the Order permanent or abandon it.

REASON: To improve road safety for all road users and following complaints from local residents and Ward Councillors regarding road safety and congestion issues
