Safeguarding is everyone's business





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- 1-You are in receipt of information or a complaint, raising an issue how an adult behaves towards children; what initial steps/action should you take?
- 2 Ensure the vulnerable individual(s) are in a safe environment (staff member also)
- 3 Establish the facts, do not investigate (at this stage) listen carefully, inquire discreetly
- 4 Collate all the information, Who is it from? Make a written record of the information (where possible in the child/adults own words), including the time, date and place of incident(s), persons present and what was said, sign and date the record
- 5 Contextualise category of abuse, behaviour, practice, contemporary or historic, 1st or 2nd hand, professional, voluntary or at home
- 6 Confidentiality as appropriate
- 7 Contact LADO within 1 working day or the next working day to access early advice and guidance

You should avoid

- Investigating or ask leading questions at initial stage seek clarification
- Making assumptions or offer alternative explanations at the initial stage
- Promising confidentiality however give assurance that the information will only be shared on a 'need to know' basis.
