

How we calculate your 2017 Council Tax bill

We've based the figures below on a Band D property in Kirklees that has no parish precept to pay.

First let's look at the 2016/17 figures we use to calculate the 2017/18 increases.

2016/17 basic Council Tax rate	+	2016/17 Adult Social Care contribution	=	Council Tax for 2016/17
£1291.89	+	£25.34	=	£1317.23

We can now use these figures to work out the council tax increases for 2017/18 as follows:

1. Calculating the Council Tax increase for 2017/18

Council Tax for 2016/17	x	Increase for 2017/18	=	Council Tax increase for 2017/18
£1317.23	x	1.99%	=	£26.21

2. Calculating the Adult Social Care contribution for 2017/18

This contribution is accumulative.

Council Tax for 2016/17	x	Increase for 2017/18	=	Amount of increase for 2017/18	+	2016/17 Adult Social Care contribution	=	Adult Social Care contribution for 2017/18
£1317.23	x	3%	=	£39.52	+	£25.34	=	£64.86

3. Calculating the basic council tax amount for 2017/18

Council Tax for 2016/17	+	Council Tax increase for 2017	-	2016/17 Adult Social Care contribution	=	2017/18 basic Council Tax rate
£1317.23	+	£26.21	-	£25.34	=	£1318.10

4. Calculating the final council tax bill for 2017 (not including parish precept)

2017/18 basic Council Tax rate	+	Adult social care contribution for 2017/18	+	West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Authority contribution	+	West Yorkshire Police Authority contribution	=	2017/18 Council Tax bill
£1318.10	+	£64.86	+	£60.89	+	£150.95	=	£1594.80
