

## How we calculate your 2019/20 Council Tax bill

We've based the figures below on a Band D property in Kirklees that has no parish precept to pay.

First let's look at the 2018/19 figures:

2018/19 basic Council Tax rate	+	2018/19 Adult Social Care contribution	=	Council Tax for 2018/19
£1359.44	+	£106.33	=	<b>£1465.77</b>

We can now use these figures to work out the Council Tax increase for 2019/20:

### 1. How we calculate the Council Tax general increase for 2019/20

Council Tax for 2018/19	x	General increase for 2019/20	=	<b>Council Tax general increase for 2019/20</b>
<b>£1465.77</b>	x	2.99%	=	<b>£43.82</b>

### 2. How we calculate the basic Council Tax amount for 2019/20

Council Tax for 2018/19	+	Council Tax general increase for 2019/20	-	Adult Social Care contribution	=	<b>2019/20 basic Council Tax</b>
<b>£1465.77</b>	+	£43.82	-	£106.33	=	<b>£1403.26</b>

### 3. Adult Social Care (ASC)

Contributions started in 2016/17 and increased year on year up to 2018/19.

**For 2019/20 there is no increase so remains the same: £106.33**

There is a requirement to have a separate line on the bill to show the amount of Council Tax which is dedicated to the provision of ASC services.

### 4. How we calculate the final Council Tax bill for 2019/20 (not including parish precept)

2019/20 basic Council Tax rate	+	Adult Social Care contribution for 2019/20	+	West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Authority contribution	+	West Yorkshire Police Authority contribution	=	<b>2019/20 Council Tax bill</b>
<b>£1403.26</b>	+	£106.33	+	£64.59	+	£186.95	=	<b>£1761.13</b>
