

## How we calculate your 2018/19 Council Tax bill

We've based the figures below on a Band D property in Kirklees that has no parish precept to pay.

First let's look at the 2017/18 figures:

2017/18 basic Council Tax rate	+	2017/18 Adult Social Care contribution	=	Council Tax for 2017/18
£1318.10	+	£64.86	=	<b>£1382.96</b>

We can now use these figures to work out the Council Tax increase for 2018/19:

### 1. How we calculate the Council Tax general increase for 2018/19

Council Tax for 2017/18	x	General increase for 2018/19	=	<b>Council Tax general increase for 2018/19</b>
<b>£1382.96</b>	x	2.99%	=	<b>£41.34</b>

### 2. How we calculate the basic Council Tax amount for 2018/19

Council Tax for 2017/18	+	Council Tax general increase for 2018/19	-	2017/18 Adult Social care contribution	=	<b>2018/19 basic Council Tax</b>
<b>£1382.96</b>	+	£41.34	-	£64.86	=	<b>£1359.44</b>

### 3. How we calculate the Adult Social Care contribution for 2018/19

Council Tax for 2017/18	x	Increase for 2018/19	=	Amount of increase for 2018/19	+	2017/18 Adult Social Care contribution	=	<b>Adult Social Care contribution for 2018/19</b>
<b>£1382.96</b>	x	3%	=	£41.47	+	£64.86*	=	<b>£106.33</b>

Adult Social Care contributions started in 2016/17 and increase year on year  
 \*£64.86 is made up of £25.34 from 2016/17 plus £39.52 from 2017/18

### 4. How we calculate the final Council Tax bill for 2018/19 (not including parish precept)

2018/19 basic Council Tax rate	+	Adult social care contribution for 2018/19	+	West Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Authority contribution	+	West Yorkshire Police Authority contribution	=	<b>2018/19 Council Tax bill</b>
<b>£1359.44</b>	+	£106.33	+	£62.72	+	£162.95	=	<b>£1691.44</b>
