STREET TRADING CONSENT

GUIDANCE NOTES

1. The Council issue a Street Trading Consent which entitles you to trade on a specific site. This Consent lasts for 12 calendar months.
2. If your designated site is on private land you will also need written permission from the owner.
3. Consultation takes place between the West Yorkshire Police and the Kirklees Environment & Transportation Service as to whether they have any objections to your using the site. The application will be presented to the Council's Regulatory Panel, should any objections/observations be received in respect of the application.
4. Any application submitted by you must be accompanied by a map and a photograph showing the site where you wish to trade, together with three passport size photographs. The fee is payable on approval, before issue of your Consent and badge.
5. You must have Public Liability Insurance for at least £5,000,000 (five million pounds). (Environment & Transportation Service may specify different, dependent on location). Before the Consent is issued a copy of your insurance must be provided.
6. Do not chose a public car park for your site as car parks are subject to the regulations governing car parks which precludes their use for commercial undertakings.
7. Planning permission may be required, should you wish to trade on a permanent site including leaving trailers overnight.
8. **You may not trade at the designated site until permission is given.**
