

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No. 15) ORDER 2017**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will, subject to certain exceptions, be to prohibit vehicles with a maximum gross weight of more than 7.5 tonnes from proceeding on any part of the following roads in Batley :-

Mill Forest Way from a point of 130m north of its junction with Grange Road/Challenge Way  
Heath Grove  
Hill Rise  
Regent Mews  
Phoenix Court  
Oaklands Drive

The Council considers these changes will alleviate congestion, maintain access and improve road safety for all road users and will stop any further damage caused by HGVs
