

## **Cleckheaton(TR)(No18)Order2016 – Statement of reasons**

### **Brunswick Street, Walkley Lane, Church Street, HECKMONDWIKE Pyenot Avenue, Centurion Way, Whitechapel Road, CLECKHEATON, Quarry Road, GOMERSAL, School Street, NORRISTHORPE**

- **Brunswick Street/Walkley Lane, Heckmondwike**

We have received complaints of visibility issues when exiting Brunswick Street onto Walkley Lane. It is therefore proposed to introduce 'No Waiting at Any time' parking restrictions on the junction of Walkley Lane and Brunswick Street for a distance of 10metres along Walkley Lane and 2metres on Brunswick Street. It is intended that these restrictions will improve visibility when exiting Brunswick Street.

- **Centurion Way, Cleckheaton**

We have received complaints on Centurion Way of double parking all the way along which restricts HGVs and bigger vehicles from accessing their units. It is proposed to add no waiting at any time restrictions along both sides of Centurion Way. It is intended this will improve access to units and businesses.

- **Church Street, Heckmondwike**

It is proposed to extend the No Waiting Mon-Sat 8am-6pm Restrictions on the junction with Thomas Street to 10metres to reinforce the Highway Code. It is also therefore proposed to move the Permit Holders Only Mon-Sat 8am-6pm bays and also extend them to 28metres.

The existing No Waiting Mon – Sat 8am – 6pm restrictions from a point 11 metres north-east of its junction with Sharpe Street for a distance of 64 metres south-westwards have been restricted and replaced with two separate restrictions. Markings will remain as on site with no change.

- **Pyenot Avenue, Cleckheaton**

We received complaints from Sykes Fold Grange that their residents have to walk round into the road due to parked cars on the bend, just before the parking bay. It is therefore proposed to implement no waiting

at any time restrictions. It is intended this will stop the issue of residents of the care home having to walk into the street.

- **Quarry Road, Gomersal**

We have received complaints due to visibility when exiting the road which accesses 155-165 Listing Lane. We have therefore proposed “No Waiting at Any Time” restrictions for 50 metres. It is intended that these restrictions will improve visibility.

- **School Street, Norristhorpe**

This order proposes to make the lengths of school keep clear markings on School Street in Norristhorpe, which are not already enforceable, subject to a traffic regulation order which will allow them to be enforced. Markings will remain as on site.

- **Whitechapel Road, Cleckheaton**

It is proposed to remove a legal order for school keep clear markings on Whitechapel Road where the markings have already been removed.
