

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL**  
**(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No.3) ORDER 2018**  
**Huddersfield Traffic Regulation (No3) Order 2018**  
**Dryclough Road, Crosland Moor and Victoria Road, Lockwood**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects lengths of roads in the Kirklees district will be to prohibit waiting at any time on both sides of Victoria Road Lockwood from the boundary of Nos. 73/75 Victoria Road for a distance of 40 metres north-eastwards; and to prohibit waiting on Monday to Friday at 8am until 9.30 am and 2.30pm until 4pm on the school Entrance Markings on Dryclough Road, Crosland Moor, on its north-east side 2 metres north-west from of the boundary of Nos. 101/103 Dryclough Road for a distance of 74 metres north-westwards

Reasons: - to prevent parking up to the build outs and blocking access along Victoria Road and to increase visibility at the improved school entrance on Dryclough Road.
