

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (No.9) ORDER 2017  
VARIOUS ROADS IN THE CLECKHEATON AND MIRFIELD AREA**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees has made the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order is to ensure that the restrictions currently shown on site at The Knowl Mirfield and various roads in Cleckheaton are mirrored in the Council's orders.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ONLY – NO CHANGES TO BE MADE ON STREET.

Kirklees Council has undertaken an audit of its Traffic Regulation Order system, and this has highlighted a variety of errors in the Orders covering sites in Mirfield and Cleckheaton. This Traffic Regulation Order will not involve any amendments to the existing signing or lining on site. Only the Orders have been corrected.

The Order will take effect on Friday, 24th November 2017.

A copy of the Order, together with a plan showing the affected length of road and a statement of reasons for making the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at:-

If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any of its provisions, on the grounds that it, or they, are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or that any requirement of the Act, or of any instrument made under the Act, has not been complied with, that person may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made (i.e. by the 9th January 2018) apply for the purpose to the High Court.
