

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL  
(SPEED LIMIT) (NO. 103) ORDER 2017  
A629 PENISTONE ROAD, SHELLEY – A629 LANE HEAD ROAD SHEPLEY -  
A629 PENISTONE ROAD BIRDSEDGE/HIGH FLATTS – B6116  
HUDDERSFIELD ROAD, HUDDERSFIELD**

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees propose to make the above Order under their powers in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which, as it affects roads on the A629 Penistone Road Shelley, Birds Edge and High Flatts, Lane Head Road Shepley and B6116 Huddersfield Road;

- A629 Penistone Road 40mph in both directions from a point 35 metres South East of the projected South Eastern kern line of Cumberworth Lane in a South Easterly Direction for a distance of 604 Meters;
- A629 Penistone Road 40mph in both directions from a point 219 meters South East of the projected South Eastern kerb line of Birdsedge Lane to a point 140m South East of its junction with the projected South Eastern kerb line of Green Lane;
- A629 Lane Head Road 40mph in both directions from a point 107 meters North West of the projected North Western Kerb line of Carr Lane for a distance of 478 meters in a North Westerly/ Northerly direction;
- B6116 Huddersfield Road 40mph from a point 25m South East of the projected South Eastern Kerb line of Queens Way to the projected North West building line of number 49 Huddersfield Road;
- The Section of A629 Penistone Road between points 1 and 2 above will revert back to 30mph by means of a system of street lighting as will the A629 Abbey Road Shelley Bank Bottom.

If the order takes effect it will revoke

- Kirklees Metropolitan Council (Speed Limit) (No.16) Order 1995, First Schedule items 1 & 2 Second Schedule item 1.
- Kirklees Metropolitan Council (Speed Limit) (No.99) Order 2014 First Schedule items 1 & 2 Second Schedule item 1
- Kirklees Metropolitan Council (Speed Limit) (No.52) Order 2005 Second Schedule item 1
