

Vehicles that can use Household Waste and Recycling Centres in Kirklees

From 11 July 2016 you will need to register your vehicle to use a Household Waste and Recycling Centre in Kirklees. We've already started registering vehicles ahead of the launch in July and you can do this on our website: www.kirklees.gov.uk/wastepermit

We issue two types of permit: a car permit and a large vehicle permit. The following information will help you to decide which permit to apply for during the registration process.

Car permit



Cars can start to use our centres once you have successfully registered your vehicle. During registration you will be asked if you plan to use a trailer when you visit our centres. Permits for cars will expire after 2 years. Trailers registered with a car are restricted to 12 visits per year.

Large vehicle permit



To register a large vehicle you will need to upload an image of page 2 of your vehicle registration document V5. During registration you will be asked if you plan to use a trailer when you visit our centres. Registration of a large vehicle can take at least three days for our decision. Permits for large vehicles will expire after 1 year or when you have used our centres 12 times.
