Time: 9am - 1pm, Monday - Friday for 2 weeks over the summer holidays

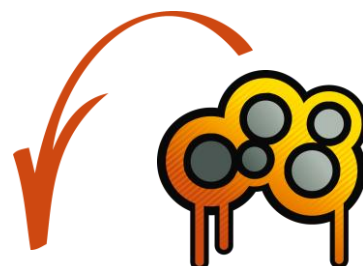
Dewsbury and District Autism Support Group

Age range: 8-12 and 13-19 year olds

Activity: Open Access activity sessions
