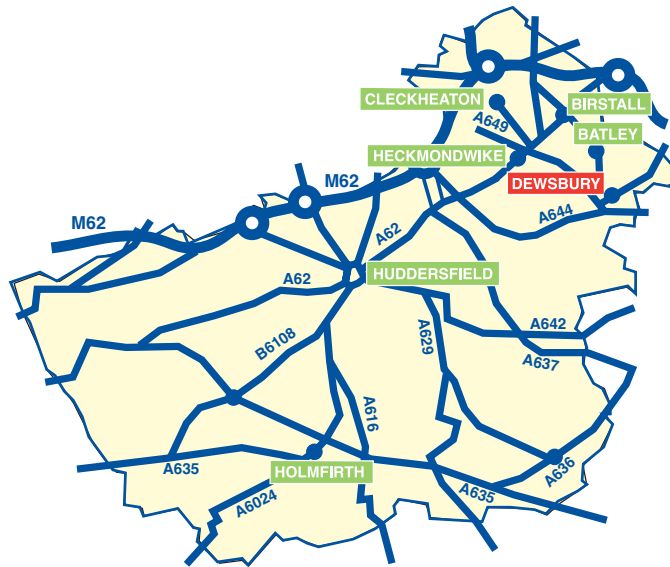

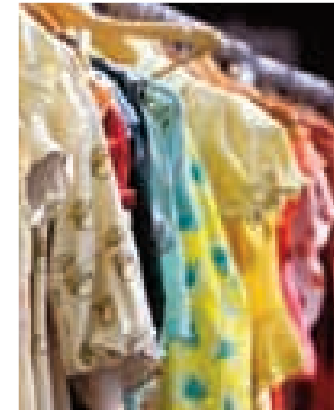
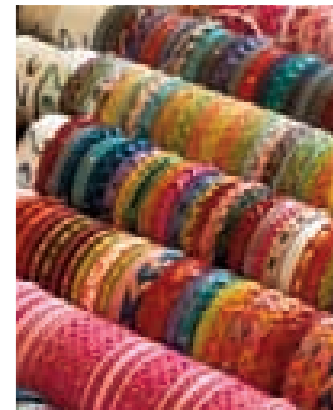

A firm favourite with coach parties and visitors to the town, Dewsbury Market is a superb destination for a day out. Coaches from across the North head for Dewsbury Market every week filled with avid shoppers who return regularly to sample the delights of this famous market.

The Market

Market Hall

Monday – Saturday (1/2 day Tuesday)

The fabulous Victorian Market Hall was the focal point of trading in Dewsbury when it was built in 1904. When it became full, traders expanded to create what is now the covered and open market. Today it is home to 38 permanent market stalls with an extensive range of fine foods and produce. Fresh meat and dairy produce, flowers, clothing and household items, together with the famous tripe stall ensure the Market Hall is as popular now as it was when it was built over 100 years ago.

Open Market

Wednesday and Saturday General Market

The largest and most renowned open market in Yorkshire, Dewsbury's famous open market boasts over 300 bustling stalls every Wednesday and Saturday. Meander through the aisles and you can be sure to find almost everything you need and many things you never knew you needed. Both locals and visitors spend hours browsing the delights on offer throughout the market.

Extending your visit

As a market town in Pennine Yorkshire, Dewsbury is a shopper's delight - from high street stores to small artists' galleries, markets and mill shops, there's truly something for everyone and make sure you don't miss the Yorkshire Mill Mile, a marathon stretch of shops between Dewsbury and Batley. Stops along the way include The Mill, Batley, the UK's largest retail mill, and Redbrick Mill, a beautiful converted Victorian weaving mill that's now home to a collection of lifestyle stores, both with ample parking for coach parties.

Dewsbury Minster

Why not take a stroll from the market to the Minster?

The Minster dates back to Anglo-Saxon times when the 7th Century missionary St Paulinus is said to have visited Dewsbury. The Church includes a heritage centre and exhibitions on the church's colourful history, some unique Anglo-Saxon sculpture and medieval stained glass. Former Curate Patrick Brontë is commemorated with a plaque inside the Minster.
