Please note the play area may not always be open during specialist events, please check before arriving.

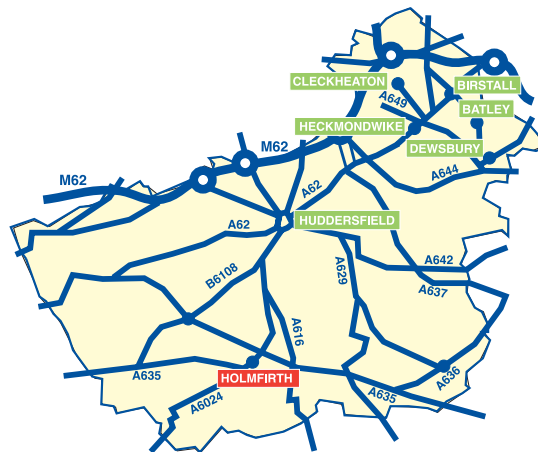
## Explore Holmfirth and the Holme Valley
