

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – Section 119
KIRKLEES METROPOLITAN COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH DENBY DALE 47 –
LOWER BUSKER FARM, SCISSET) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2003**


On 11 March 2026 Kirklees Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that part of public footpath Denby Dale 47 shown on the order plan by a bold solid line commencing at its junction with Busker Lane at grid reference 2466 1035 (point A on the order plan) and proceeding in a north westerly direction for approximately 62 metres to grid reference 2462 1041 (point B on the order plan) to a new line shown on the order plan by a bold dashed line commencing at its junction with Busker Lane at grid reference 2460 1035 (point C on the order plan) and proceeding in a north then north easterly direction for approximately 66 metres to grid reference 2462 1041 (point B on the order plan) to rejoin the existing path.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map may be seen free of charge at Denby Dale Community Library, Wakefield Road, Denby Dale, Huddersfield HD8 8RX during normal library opening hours.

The order came into force as from 11 March 2026, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 20 March 2026, make an application to the High court.
