On 20 October 2023 Kirklees Council confirmed the above order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to extinguish that part of public footpath Denby Dale 82 shown on the plan attached to the order by bold solid line commencing at point A on Longroyd Lane at grid reference SE 2099 0968 and proceeding in a south south-easterly direction for 182 metres to point B at Top o' th' Close at grid reference SE 2107 0952.

The order came into force as from 20 October 2023, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 of the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 27 October 2023, make an application to the High court.
