

**WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 – SECTION 53
WEST YORKSHIRE METROPOLITAN COUNTY COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND
STATEMENT FOR THE KIRKLEES AREA**

**KIRKLEES COUNCIL (KIRKBURTON 257 – FARNLEY BANK WOOD) DEFINITIVE
MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2024**

The above Order, made on 08 March 2024, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding a footpath as follows:

A footpath, as shown on the Order Map by the bold dashed line at Farnley Tyas between points A-B-C on the Order Map commencing at its junction with public footpath Kirkburton 55/10 at grid reference SE 1676 1343 (point A on the Order Map) and leading generally south-southwest for approximately 600 metres through Farnley Bank Wood with a width of 1.5 metres to its junction with the access road to Farnley Tyas Bowling Club (point B on the Order Map) at grid reference SE 1651 1291 and then leading generally west-southwest for approximately 20 metres with a variable width of 3.8m to 4.6 metres within the area hatched/edged blue (point B to point C on the Order Map) to its junction with Woodsome Road opposite no. 8 Dartmouth Terrace at grid reference SE 1650 1290 (point C on the Order Map).

Any representations or objections relating to the Order must be sent or delivered in writing addressed to Harry Garland, Kirklees Council, Legal Services, PO Box 1720, Huddersfield, HD1 9EL not later than 26 April 2024. You should quote reference HG/D105-175 and state the grounds on which your objection/representation is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Kirklees Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (or part of it if the authority has by notice to the Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment Food and Rural Affairs, in whole or in part, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
