

PUBLIC NOTICE

Highways Act 1980, Section 118 & 26. Proposed concurrent extinguishment and creation orders at Robin Lane, Heckmondwike, WF16 0DW

Grid Reference: SE 2240 2318

Notice is hereby given that an application has been received by Kirklees Council to address an obstruction of an unrecorded public right of way known as Robin Lane by residential properties since 1996. The application is made in lieu of enforcement action at this time and seeks a Public Path Extinguishment Order, under [s.118 of the Highways Act, 1980](#), to extinguish:

- The full length and width of a section of unrecorded restricted byway known as 'Robin Lane' some 95 metres in length as shown by the bold solid black line commencing on Cawley Lane at grid reference SE 2236 2318 (Point A on the Map) and leading generally east-north-easterly to Capas Heights Way at grid reference SE 2246 2317 (Point B on the Map)
- The full length and width of part of a recorded public footpath known as 'Heckmondwike 19' some 19 metres in length as shown by the bold black solid lines commencing on Cawley Lane at grid reference SE 2238 2316 (Point C on the Map) and leading generally north-westerly to join Robin Lane at grid reference SE 2237 2318 (Point D on the Map).

The application also seeks a concurrent Public Path Creation Order under [s.26 of the Highways Act, 1980](#), to create:

- An alternative public footpath some 77 metres in length with a width of 2 metres as shown by the bold black dashed lines commencing on Cawley Lane at grid reference SE 2238 2316 (Point E on the Map) and leading north-easterly then east-south-easterly to join Capas Heights Way at grid reference SE 2245 2318 (Point F on the Map).

Please note that this notice forms part of the preliminary consultation exercise on the applicant's proposal and that no decision on the application has yet been made by the Council. An explanatory statement has also been prepared.
