

## **NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

### **TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 – SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14**

#### **KIRKLEES COUNCIL PUBLIC FOOTPATHS SPENBOROUGH 24 (PART) AND SPENBOROUGH 42 (PART) LAND AT WHITECHAPEL ROAD, CLECKHEATON PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023**

On the 06 March 2024 Kirklees Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order will be to stop up the following footpaths:

1. That part of public footpath Spenborough 24 having a width of 1.2 metres and shown on the Order Plan by a bold solid line commencing at point A at grid reference SE 1786 2590 and proceeding in a north north-westerly direction for 107 metres to point B at SE 1783 2600; and
2. That part of public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width of 1.2 metres and shown on the Order Plan by a bold solid line commencing at point B at grid reference SE 1783 2600 and proceeding in a north easterly then north north-easterly direction for 196 metres to point C at SE 1795 2614

Alternative footpaths will be created, namely:

1. Public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width of 2 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point A at grid reference SE 1786 2589 and proceeding in a north-easterly direction for 20 metres to point D at grid reference SE 1787 2591 then proceeding in a north north-westerly then north north-easterly direction for 67 metres to point E at grid reference SE 1788 2596 then in a north north-easterly then north-westerly direction for 77 metres to point F at grid reference SE 1784 2601 then in a north north-easterly direction for 131 metres to point L at SE 1790 2613;
2. Public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width of 3 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point L at grid reference SE 1790 2613 and proceeding in a north north-easterly direction for 33 metres to point G at grid reference SE 1792 2616;
3. Public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width varying between 2.5 and 3 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point G at grid reference SE 1792 2616 and proceeding in a south easterly direction for 37 metres to point C at SE 1795 2614;
4. Public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width of 2 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point E at grid reference SE 1788 2596 and proceeding in an east south-easterly direction for 10 metres to point H at grid reference SE 1788 2596 then in a north-easterly then north north-easterly direction for 167 metres to point J at grid reference SE 1797 2610;

5. Public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width of 2.5 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point J at grid reference SE 1797 2610 and proceeding in a north north-easterly then north-westerly direction for 57 metres to point C at grid reference SE 1795 2614; and
6. Public footpath Spenborough 42 having a width of 3 metres shown on the Order Plan by a bold dashed line commencing at point G at grid reference SE 1792 2616 and proceeding in north north-easterly direction for 4 metres to point K at grid reference SE 1792 2616

The Order came into force on 06 March 2024 but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
