

The Council of the Borough of Kirklees Public Space Protection Order (Marsden Town Centre)

This order is made by The Council of the Borough of Kirklees (“the Council”) and shall be known as the Marsden Town Centre Public Space Protection Order (“this Order”)

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2025 and shall have an effect for 3 years thereafter, unless extended by further order as set out in the Act.
2. The Council is satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 59 (2) of the Act have been met, namely that certain activities carried out in a public place within the authority’s area have had or it is likely that they will have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality.
3. The Council is also satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 59 (3) of the Act have been met namely, that the effect or likely effect of the activities is, or is likely to be, of a persistent or continuing nature and that these activities are unreasonable and justify the restrictions imposed by the Order and that it is all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purpose of reducing crime and/or anti-social behaviour in a public place.
4. The Outlined Plan marked in red applies to all the orders below,

The Order

Prohibitions	Requirements	Area Affected
Street Drinking	No person shall consume alcohol in any public place in the Town Centre other than at licensed premises or shall be in possession of any opened vessel containing or reasonably believed to contain alcohol in any public place save for those places identified by Section 62 of the Act.	Within Marsden Town Centre
No urination or defecation in public places	No person shall urinate or defecate in any public place; this does not include public toilets.	Within Marsden Town Centre


