Multiply is the free, government-funded, adult maths support programme, part of Levelling Up, Skills for Life, the Department for Education, and the UK Shared Prosperity Fund. The Multiply programme aims to boost people's ability to use maths in their daily lives, at home and at work.

Whether that be improving household finances, helping children with homework, making more sense of the facts in the media, or improving numeracy skills specific to a line of work.

All adults (19 years and over) who need to improve their numeracy (up to and including level 2 or equivalent) will be able to access free flexible courses and initiatives that fit around their lives - whether this is in person or online, at work or in their own time (evenings, part-time or intensively).
