



Privacy Notice & Data Consent Form Kirklees Wellness Service

The Kirklees Wellness Service takes your data and privacy seriously and will only use your data in ways that you have consented. We use the information that we collect about you in order to assess your need for support against our commissioning specification. It will also enable us to determine if there are other options available to you from our partners in health, community and voluntary organisations. This information will be stored securely and you have the right to see the information we hold about you at any time.

The categories of information that we collect, process, hold and share include:

- Personal Information (Title, Name, Date of Birth, Address, Contact Information)
- Characteristics (Gender, Ethnicity, Disabilities, Long Term Health Conditions, Language, Religion)

Why we collect and hold this information

We use this personal data in order to:

- To provide you access to the Kirklees Wellness Service
- To monitor the demographic of the people we work
- Enable us to carry out specific functions for which we are responsible;
- Assess the quality of our services;
- Evaluate and improve our performance;
- Derive statistics which inform decisions about future delivery of services.

The lawful basis on which we use this information

We collect and process information about you, we require you to provide consent for us to do this. If you do not consent or withdraw consent at a later date, we may be unable to continue to support you with this service.

In some cases, special categories of personal data such as Racial or Ethnic origin, Religious beliefs and Health associated data is also required.

By signing this form you are providing your consent for us to collect and store your personal information so that we can provide you with a service detailed above.

Storing this information

We will hold the information about you securely, and for no longer than reasonably necessary. We will access your information for the duration of our intervention with yourself up to 12 months, however it will remain on the specified social care database (Brand4) in accordance with Kirklees Councils retention schedule for up to 7 years after death or cessation of the service, unless you request a right to erasure. We will do this to comply with statutory requirements; in case of legal claims/complaints; for safeguarding purposes and service evaluation.

Who we share this information with

We routinely share this information with:

- **Other Services within Kirklees Council ie:** Community Plus, Children & Adult Social Services, Financial Services, Health Services and Early Intervention & Prevention.
- **National Government Departments ie:** Employment Services & Emergency Services
- **Other Partners ie:** Community Health Services ie: GP, Community Sector, 3rd Sector, Voluntary Sector, Charitable Sector and Housing.

There may be circumstances where we need to share your data with other organisations or services which aren't listed above. We will obtain your consent prior to doing this.
