Enabling Light & Dark Modes

1. Open press reader and select the 'more' button in the bottom right corner of your screen.

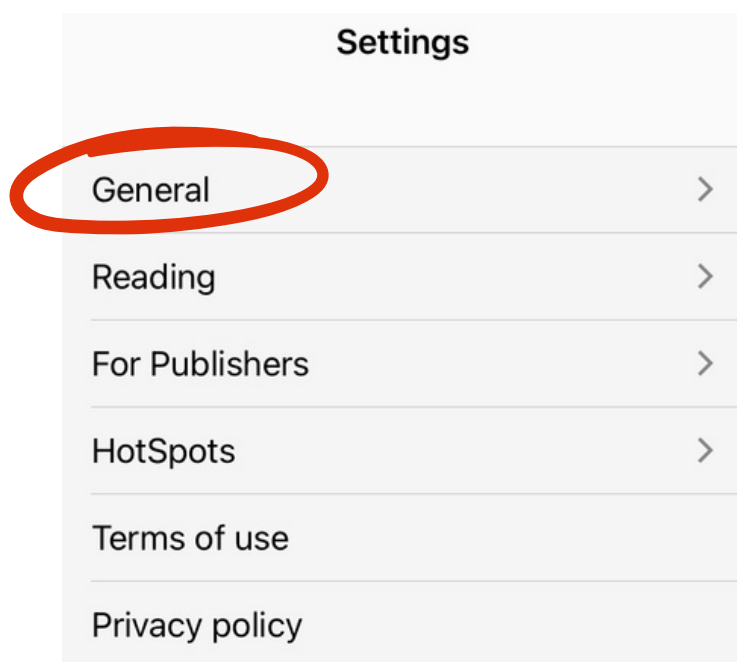
The button looks like this:



2. Select the 'Settings' button.



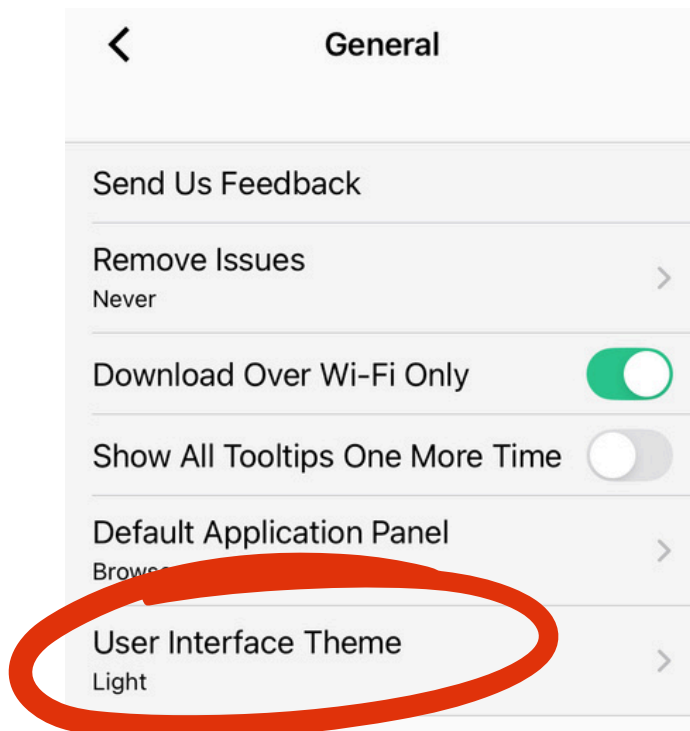
3. Then in the settings menu, select 'General'.



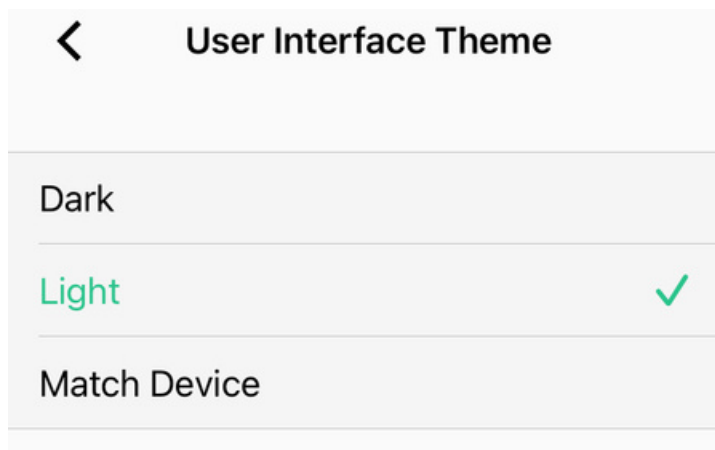

Enabling Light & Dark Modes (continued)

4. From here, select 'User Interface Theme'.



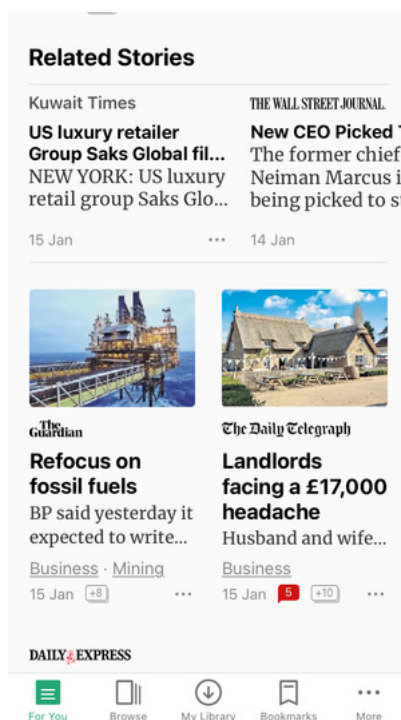
5. Now choose between 'Light or Dark'.



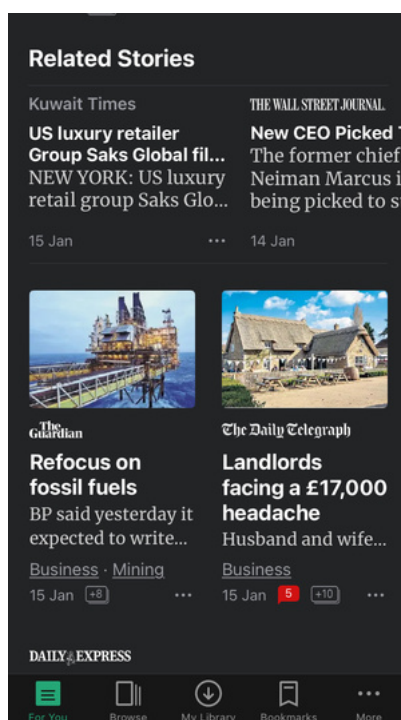

Enabling Light & Dark Modes (continued)

Light Mode looks like this:



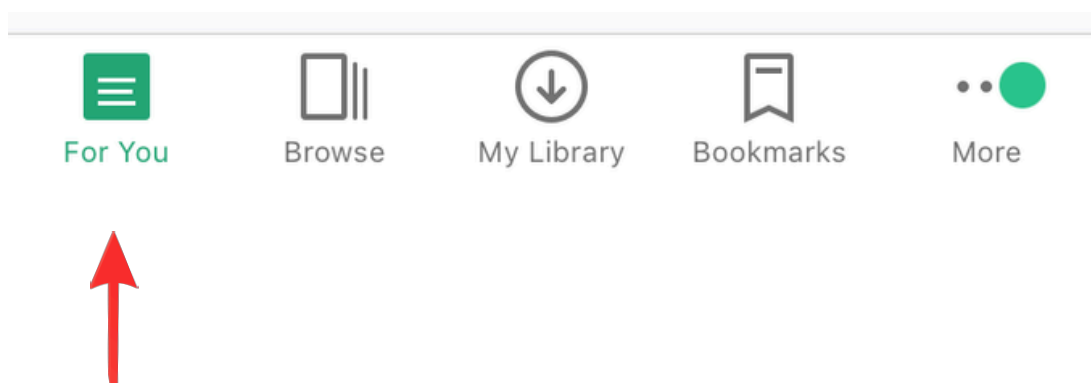
Dark Mode looks like this:

Adjusting Text Size

1. Make sure you are on the 'For you' page of PressReader, do this by pressing the 'For You' button in the bottom left corner of your screen.



2. Select an article you wish to read.
3. Select the text symbol at the bottom of your screen.

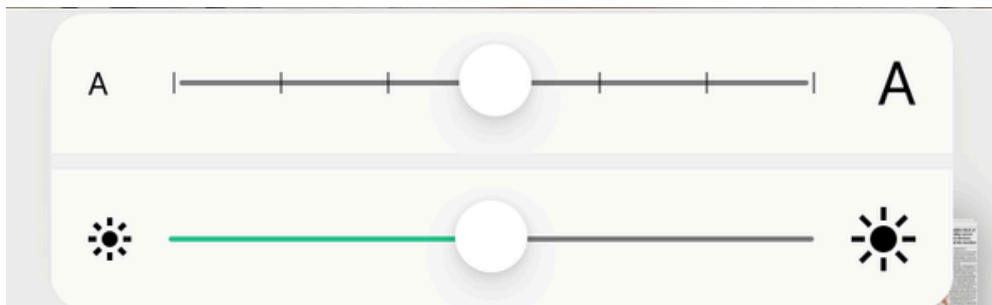

Adjusting Text Size (continued)

4. Two sliders will pop up, to adjust text size, drag the top slider right to increase the text size or left to decrease the text size.

Additionally, the bottom slider lets you increase or decrease the brightness of the screen.

Text View vs Page View

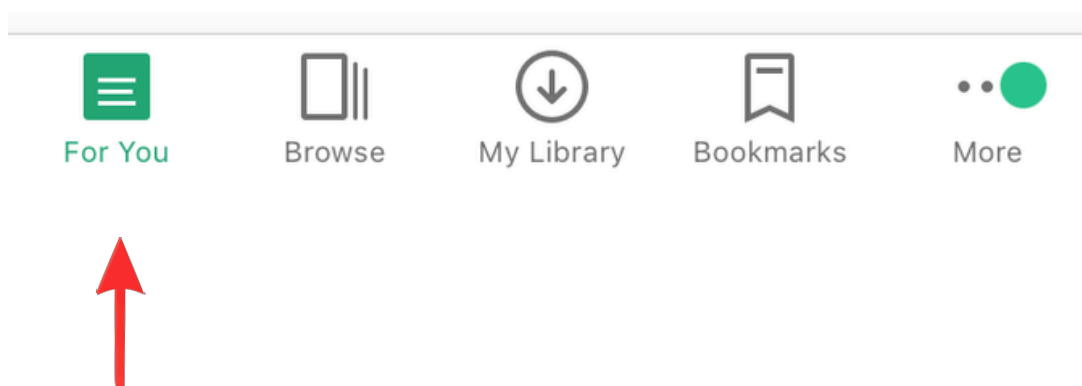
In Pressreader, there are two different ways to view articles:

‘Text View’ offers a more simplified text format.

‘Page View’ displays the publication as it appears in print.

Text View:

1. Make sure you are on the ‘For you’ page of PressReader, do this by pressing the ‘For You’ button in the bottom left corner of your screen.

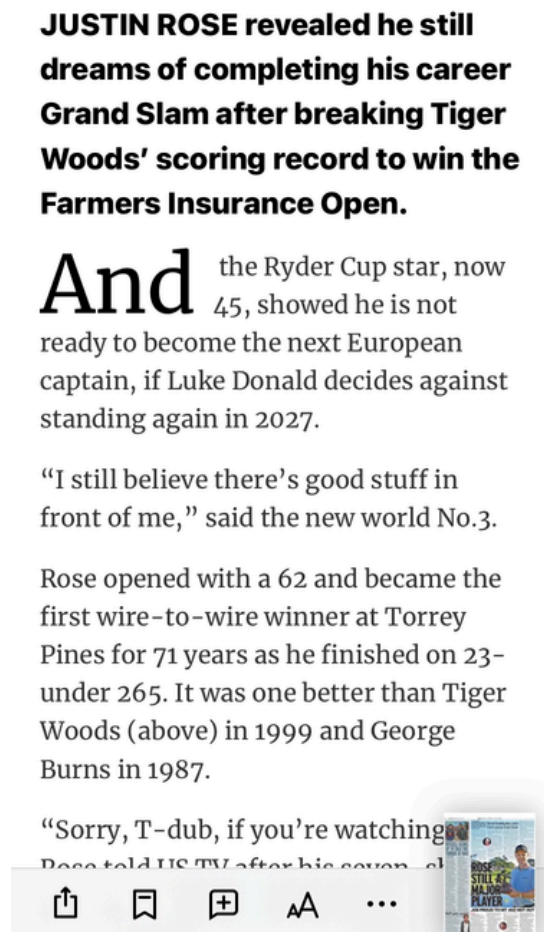


2. Select an article.

Text View vs Page View (continued)

3. The article should open up in Text View by default, it will look like this:



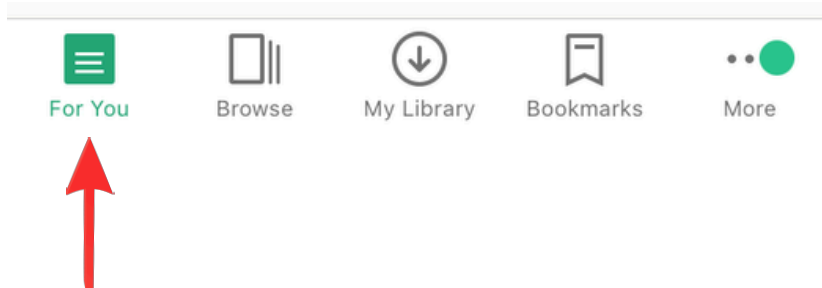
To navigate through the article, drag your finger up your screen to scroll down the article and drag your finger down your screen to scroll up the article.

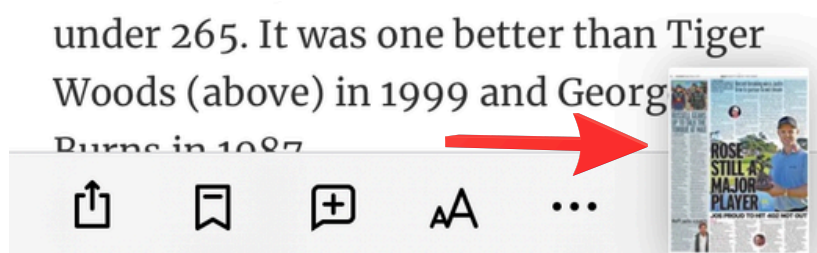
Text View vs Page View (continued)

Page View

1. Make sure you are on the 'For you' page of PressReader, do this by pressing the 'For You' button in the bottom left corner of your screen.



2. Select an article
3. The article should open up in Text View by default, to change this select the image in the bottom right of your screen to open up the article in page view.



To navigate through the article use one finger to move around the different paragraphs, images and titles.

PressReader Accessibility

Zoom functions in Page View:

Zooming in and out (option 1).

You can zoom into parts of the article by aiming your finger at where you want to zoom into and quickly double tapping. The screen will zoom into the area that you aimed at. To zoom back out, double tap again.

Zooming in and out (option 2).

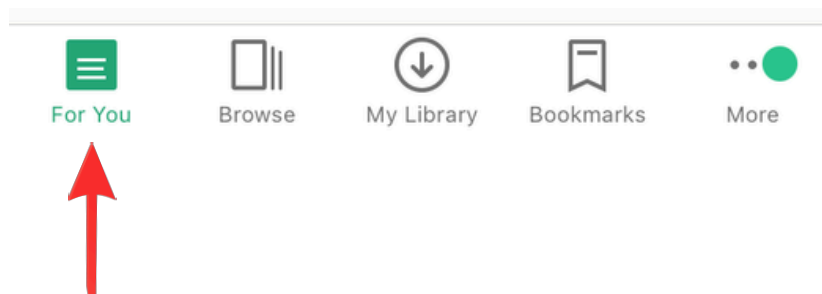
To zoom in, pinch two fingers together, place them on the screen and drag them away from each other in opposite directions. The more you drag your fingers away, the more the screen will zoom in.

To zoom out, you do the opposite motion. Place two fingers on the screen, away from each other and drag them until they are together, this will zoom the page out.

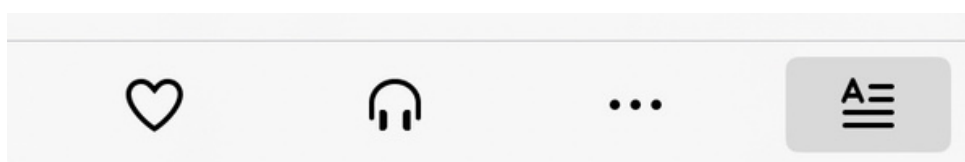

Listening to Articles

1. Make sure you are on the 'For you' page of PressReader, do this by pressing the 'For You' button in the bottom left corner of your screen.



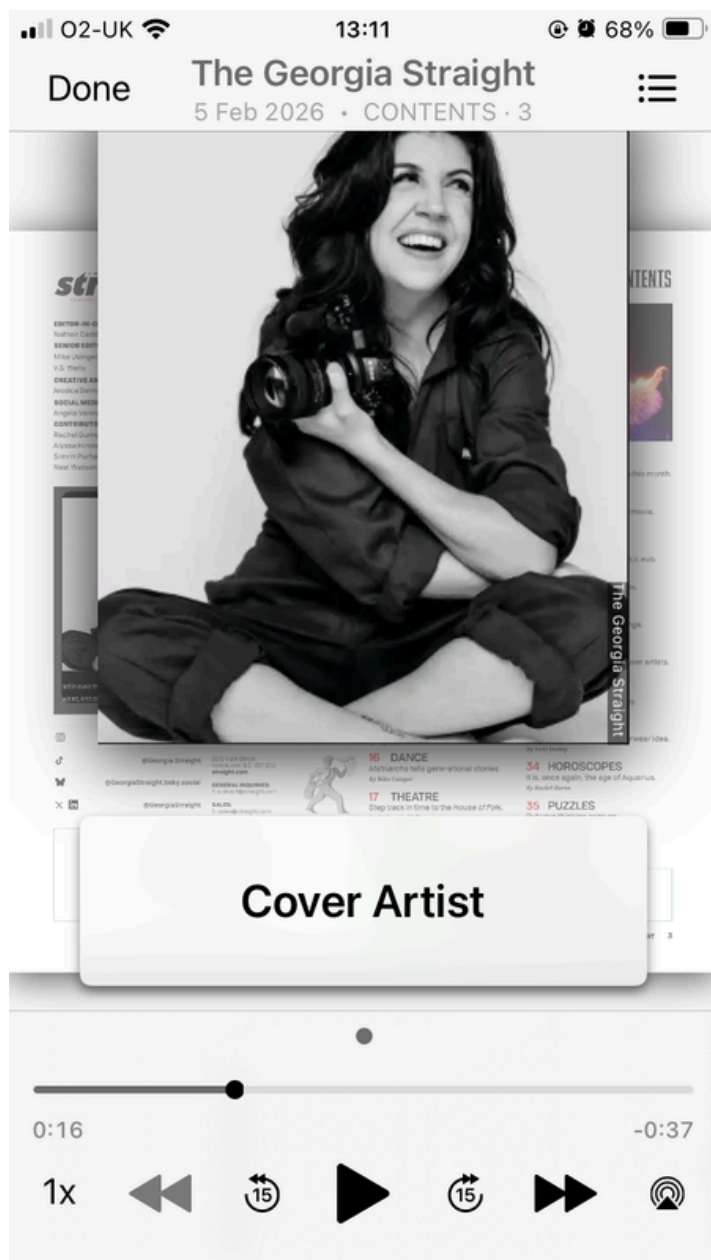
2. At the bottom of your screen, select the headphones icon.

Listening to Articles (continued)

You will now hear the article being read aloud, PressReader will also open the article in a new view which looks like this:



PressReader Accessibility

Listening to Articles (continued)

The buttons in this view do the following:

1x

Change the speed of the voice



Go back to previous article



Rewind 15 seconds



Pause



Fast forward 15 seconds



Go forwards to next article
