**Taxi Stands in Dewsbury**

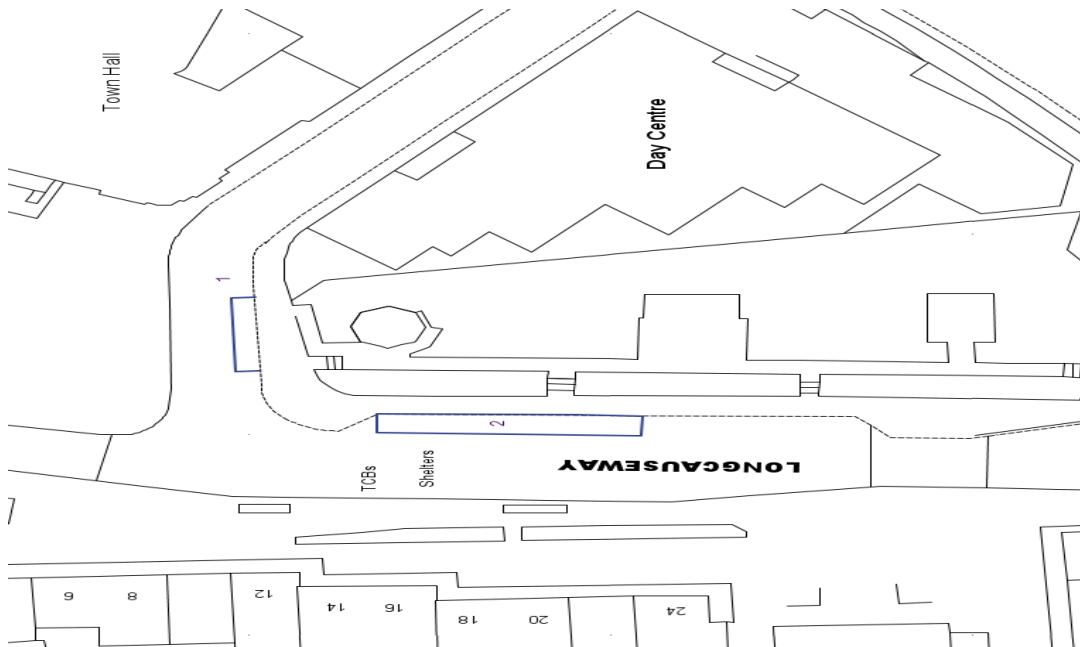
NOTICE is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 63 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976, Kirklees Council proposes to remove and extend a hackney carriage stand(s) at the locations specified below.

**Town Hall Way - Dewsbury**

It is proposed to remove the taxi stand labelled number one (Town Hall Way) on the map shown below. Stand number one is for 3 vehicles and operates twenty-four hours, seven days a week.

**Longcauseway – Dewsbury**

It is proposed to extend the current rank labelled number two (Longcauseway) on the map shown below. Stand number two currently accommodates 2 hackney carriages, the proposal is to increase this to four hackney carriage vehicles operating twenty four hours, seven days a week.
