In pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and Order the KIRKLEES METROPOLITAN COUNCIL (hereinafter called "The Council") as Local Planning Authority hereby refuses to permit:-

FORMATION OF 3 NO. CAR PARKING SPACES

At: 48, HEALEY LANE, BATLEY, WF17 7ST

In accordance with the plan(s) and applications submitted to the Council on 26 April 2005. The reasons for the Council's decision to refuse permission for the development are:

- (1)** It is considered that the formation of the parking spaces would not be in the best interests of both pedestrian and highway safety and be contrary to Policies BE1, BE2, D2 and T10 of the Kirklees Unitary Development Plan.
- (2)** It is considered that the creation of the parking space and loss of the mature tree within the streetscene would be detrimental to the visual amenities of the area and would therefore be contrary to Policies BE2 and D2 of the Kirklees Unitary Development Plan.
