PLANNING PERMISSION FOR DEVELOPMENT

In pursuance of its powers under the above-mentioned Act and Order the Kirklees Council (hereinafter called "The Council") as Local Planning Authority hereby permits:-

ERECTION OF CONSERVATORY

At: 6 Teasel Close oakenshaw, BD12 7DH

In accordance with the plan(s) and applications submitted to the Council on 12 Jun 2006, subject to the condition(s) specified hereunder:-

(1) The development shall be begun not later than the expiration of 3 years beginning with the date on which permission is granted.

(2) The development hereby permitted shall be carried out in complete accordance with the approved plans and specifications specifically with regard to siting, design and materials except as may be required by other conditions unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Local Planning Authority.

(3) The materials used for the dwarf wall shall match those used on the existing building in terms of type, colour, texture and scale.

The reasons for the Council's decision to grant permission for the development subject to compliance with the conditions specified are:-

(1) Pursuant to Section 91 of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990, as amended by the planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

(2) So as to ensure the satisfactory appearance of the development on completion.

(3) In the interests of visual amenity and to accord with policy BE13 of the Unitary Development Plan.

The decision to grant planning permission has been taken having regard to the policies and proposals in the Kirklees Unitary Development Plan set out below, and to all other relevant material considerations:

BE13 - Extensions to dwellings (design principles)

BE14 - Extensions to dwellings (scale)

D2 - Unallocated land
