The art stone is Marshalls pitch face Yorkstone and the natural is Stainton semi-pitched face natural stone walling 140mm.

Quick question regarding the blockwork: from the construction notes it says 10N blocks for the ground floor and 7.3N blocks thereafter. Some of the merchants have quoted for standard dense blocks of 7.3N and 10N, some have quoted for breeze blocks instead of the 7.3N dense blocks, and others have quoted for 3.6N thermalite blocks. What do we actually need to use and where – I'm confused!

Also, any further info on the ventilation stuff?
