E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

The narrow strip of woodland between Blackmoorfoot Reservoir and Reservoir Side Road is heavily used by members of the public walking dogs or jogging, cars belonging to the public are often parked on Reservoir Side Road.

Tree 48, Common Beech, there is extensive decay in the trunk as can be seen in the photographs. Because of the decay I propose to pollard the tree at approximately 6m. from ground level, retaining the decaying stem for its conservation / wildlife habitat value. The tree is identified with a metal tag.

Tree 49, Rowan, this dead tree is leaning toward the road, my request is to fell the tree removing the hazard.

Tree 50, Rowan, this is in fact two dead trees adjacent to each other, one of which is hung up in a Beech tree, my proposal is to fell both trees.

Tree 51, Rowan, this has severe crown die back and is shedding branches, again the proposal is to fell the tree.

I would plan not to undertake any replanting work due to the amount of work Yorkshire Water already carry out for the benefit of the public.
