Prior notification for single storey rear extension**

I refer to your submission of details relative to the proposed extension as described below for the above property and as submitted on 16-Jan-2017.

The proposal is for erection of single storey rear extension. The extension projects 5.5m beyond the rear wall of the original dwellinghouse. The maximum height of the extension is 3.6m, the height of the eaves of the extension is 2.7m

It has been determined that the proposal is not acceptable and prior approval is hereby **Refused** for the following reason(s);

1. The single storey rear extension would exceed the limitations of permitted development in terms of the projection from the original rear wall of the dwelling. The property has a two storey rear extension which projects 4.2m from the original rear wall of the dwelling. The proposed extension, with a 5.5m projection, would when considered with the previous extensions to the proposed, exceed the 8m limitations set out in the General Permitted Development Order 2015, Part 1, Class A, (g).

**Appeals to the Secretary of State**

The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of a notice of appeal but will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of appeal.
