I have no objection to the proposals. The proposals show the removal and replacement of one tree however there is much more room for tree planting within the proposals which should be taken advantage of to improve the streetscene.

In addition the demolition and construction is likely to damage the adjacent cherry tree (T3) shown as retained. As this tree was in a poor condition I would rather this tree be replaced with another Hornbeam in the same place. This would allow more room for the works to be carried out and ensure the long term benefit of a good quality tree in this position for the future.
