Existing walls are brick walls about 1 meter high. On top of them we will be erecting a fence to reach the total height of 7 feet. On at least two sides of the property we have thick hedges, on those sides we would be using simple anti climb mesh.

The proposed fence will be made of composite wood and Metal. The composite wood will be either dark/chocolate brown or black in colour with black metallic borders. With matching gates. The anti climb mesh with the trees/hedges will be metallic mesh in black colour and wouldnt be visible to neighbors or public due to a high hedge in the middle.
