I hope there hasn't been a confusion in explaining the final outlook of the proposed fence. Please see attached picture which shows the final outlook. The cladding/pailings used will be factory finished, i can bring some samples to your office for you to look. It's the most expensive, longest lasting (20 years guaranteed) and aesthetically appealing product you can get on the market these days. And the metal Posts won't be galvanized (as they won't allow paintwork) the posts will be mild steel which i can spray paint/heat paint just like factory and that will not be an issue.

This type of setup only applies to residential market and from the pictures you can clearly see they are a lot better looking than the traditional painted timber fence used everywhere in our area.
