<p>I OBJECT to the proposed building works for the following reasons as listed below. The area at the moment is greenfield and is used by the wider local community for dog walking, walking, playing etc..and there is an abundance of wild life including Jays. There are also several trees and bushes which are not mentioned in the planning report.</p> <p>This area is already struggling with heavy traffic as Horton Street is used as rat run to avoid the centre of Heckmondwike and is also used for parking for the Grammar School. During commuter times the area is often impassable due to the number of cars particularly on Church Street, Horton Street and Brunswick Street.</p> <p>Heckmondwike already has a weak infrastructure and congestion at times is horrific, the B6117 is the ninth most congested route in the UK (according to Inrix). This development will add to this congestion, not only during development with site traffic but then with residential traffic once completed. Local schools are currently oversubscribed therefore families moving in to the development will have to travel by car to schools further afield adding to even more traffic congestion during the school run.</p> <p>I am really disappointed that another application has been proposed when the objections to the previous application are unchanged.</p>
