<p>I object to this planning application for the following reasons:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. It will result in an intolerable increase in the amount of traffic in the local area, not just during the earth removal and subsequent building development, but a permanent increase based on the number of people who are expected to live there.2. The process of driving in the piles on which the houses will be built is extremely noisy and will cause an excruciatingly high level of noise pollution in the surrounding area, to the detriment of out enjoyment of the area.3. There is limited access for heavy vehicles and a substantial increase in the number of heavy vehicles using local roads will be dangerous for other road users and pedestrians.4. The area is an open greenspace which over the years has become a habitat for wildlife It could and should be developed sympathetically along the lines of the existing Greenway and Ringway. There are other brownfield sites elsewhere in Kirklees which can be developed for housing in preference to this area.5. Heckmondwike has had enough housing development in the past few years, the recent development of housing in Brunswick Street has added a significant number of people and cars to the local area. With local road, schools and public services already being stretched close to breaking point, any substantial increase in the local population will make a bad situation even worse. <p>I do not want this development, and neither do many of my neighbours.
