<p>I object to this application on the following grounds.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Noise from the proposed development will be unbearable. Pile driving and noise from movement of soil will be heard by all the neighbouring houses and surrounding area as noise echoes up the hillside. I can hear local bands playing in Heckmondwike in my garden to give you an example of how noise travels up from the valley.2. Pollution from the dust on the site. Numerous lorries travelling to the site. Then another 150 cars in this area. Our air quality is poor in this area this will only add pollution.3. Traffic is heavy in this area. The access to the site has already more than enough cars parked or travelling through this area particularly during rush hour particularly with the extra traffic for Heckmondwike grammar school. Families living in this area will have the area choked with cars and lorries. Also Heckmondwike Road, Walkley Lane and Halifax Road cannot support an extra 150 cars this development will bring.4. This development will cause the loss of valuable green space, the loss of wild flowers, butterflies, trees, and we are likely to lose bats that nest in the area and also our fox population that have lived in that area to my knowledge for over 55 years. Please protect our green spaces.5. The development has not considered maintaining or planning for the cycle way. We should not lose this opportunity.6. I believe flooding may occur in this area again because of the loss of soil, trees and plant life replaced by tarmac and concrete.7. I believe that are schools, doctors and hospitals may struggle to accommodate more residents.8. Our area is choked with housing and over populated please do not deprive us of much needed nature and greenery.
