Then if the application is granted for access it doesn't stop there there has been no mention in the reports of how there going to deal with the noise pollution from the pilling to which I know from my line of work is a very noisy process there are many residents around this site that work shifts and nights . The process of building these 76 houses is not going to be short term is going to be long term residents shouldn't have to put up with sitting in there gardens listening to all this noise and the dust levels that are going to be produced from within the site it's self . Residents won't be able to open windows in there own property for some considerable time surly that's not right . And there's the fact of the ecological reports to which are so far from the truth it's unbelievable. There are birds bats ,newts , red kites, foxes. I've even seen herons sat on my rear fence , so why do all the reports come back so differently can you please address this .
