Dear sir or Madam

I am writing to you to object to the above proposed planning application.

The reasons why I am objecting are as follows:

VERY RESTRICTED ACCESS TO AND FROM HALL LANE AT THE JUNCTION WITH THE COMBS.

As I am sure you are aware, this junction is directly situated on a very sharp, almost blind 180 degree bend. This makes both turning into and leaving Hall Lane particularly dangerous, especially when turning right and heading towards Dewsbury.

I understand that this development is for 30 dwellings and therefore on the assumption that 30 dwellings, with 2 cars per dwelling, and with a minimum of 2 vehicle movements per day would amount to 120 vehicle movements per day minimum.

Also this figure does not take into account current existing households and farm equipment and deliveries. Simply put the access is totally inadequate for a development of this many dwellings and I would respectfully urge you to refuse this application.
