Good afternoon,

I appreciate there may be delay in responding to this email due to current circumstances.

I would like to formally update some information in reference to the planning application 2018/92842 for Hall Lane, Thornhill.

I note no decision has been made and have new information. I, along with other residents, commented in 2018 that we have nesting Tawny owls and bats in the proposed construction zone. We now also have a nesting woodpecker. All 3 species are subject to habitat protection under the Countryside and Wildlife Act 1981, habitat that this application seeks permission to destroy.

I refer only and specifically to the small band of trees between Hall Lane Cottages and the proposed construction site, where the Electrical Substation is, which the current plan states will be cut down, completely removing the entire habitat.

Could I please request this updated information be passed to the appropriate Planning Officer for further action and, when possible could I please have a formal acknowledgement of this updated information relevant to the above application.
