<p>TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAY OBJECTION:</p> <p>My objection to this development is very simple and logical: Building 226 new family homes within a site that does not have the supporting road infrastructure in place will cause the already very heavily congested roads surrounding the site to become paralysed. Namely, Nabcroft Lane leading to Swan Lane and Blackmoorfoot Lane will become so congested at peak hours that the additional vehicles will cause grid-lock for hours.</p> <p>I base my argument on the additional MINIMUM of 226 cars or vans that will accompany this estate, and others that will be visiting for business or pleasure. The ONLY solution to this problem would be to radically change the road infrastructure BEFORE the housing estate was completed.</p> <p>Let me say that I ENCOURAGE the building of these new houses, but ONLY IF THE SURROUNDING ROADS ARE MAJORLY ALTERED TO ACCOMMODATE THE EXTRA VOLUME OF TRAFFIC INTO AND OUT OF THE EXISTING ROADS.</p>
