Thank you for your letter, dated today, via email, regarding the above.

I am now more sure than not, that no consideration whatsoever is given to letters of objection, or those asking for further information, or clarification.

You state that my letter will be taken into consideration when making a decision on the application. That is very interesting, bearing in mind that the application was apparently GRANTED ON 17 December 2018.

I would now like a reply which answers specific queries raised in both my initial, and subsequent, letters, not just a computer generated missive, which is complete nonsense. It makes a mockery of the planning department's means of "corresponding" with members of the public, or operating an honest and open policy to all.

Your response really does prove several points I made in my last letter. Your "system", particularly the application form, allows applicants to gloss over their intentions without specifically stating **exactly** what is being applied for. This is grossly unfair to anyone wishing to object. There is little wonder that people are beginning to think it is pointless objecting, especially in Oxford Road, because invariably these sketchy applications are automatically granted. Are applicants told that, despite several objections, applications WILL be granted? I sincerely hope not, but I, along with several neighbours, are beginning to feel that, sadly, we are correct in our assumptions.

Would someone now, please, take responsibility for answering my previous letters, together with comments in this email, and not just try to fob me off. Believe me, I will not be "fobbed", and will take this further if necessary.
