The building design proposed is not in keeping with the historical buildings remaining both on the Hill site and in the surrounding areas.2. The archeological site is not one which should be commercialised with a hotel and restaurant.3. A better development would be a building (perhaps Victorian in style) which would service the site by providing "visitors" with a cafe and a visitors centre which would outline the historical remains of the site.4 I do not believe that an ultra modern hotel is necessary on this site.
