I wish to make a comment on application 2018/62/93591/W, however your website will not allow me to search for my address. Here is my comment:

I strongly oppose this development on several grounds. Firstly, the proposed building is far too large and would create an unnecessary blot on the landscape, able to be seen from far and wide. Similarly, the build design is not at all sympathetic to the ancient and historic site.

This development would place far too much strain on the site – the surrounding area is already congested, and the access road would be decimated by building traffic and subsequent customer traffic. Again, not at all in keeping with the ancient history of Castle Hill.

Also, Victoria Tower is already open and staffed by wonderful, knowledgeable visitor assistants. This proposal is an insult to those people who provide excellent assistance to visitors to the tower – this already exists, so the proposals around ‘opening up the tower’ are completely moot. This is being done to a high standard already and just represents pandering to try to force this application through.

The site would benefit from being closed to vehicles on an evening, preventing the antisocial behaviour that is becoming more prevalent – closing off the vehicular access would be a simple solution to this issue.
