<p>Kirklees Flood Management and Drainage, as the Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA), have previously provided comments on this application (dated 21 November 2018) requesting further information to be provided as the details submitted at the time were insufficient to make an informed decision.</p> <p>The applicant submitted a number of updated drawings and documents in the recent weeks. However, none of those refer to drainage matters.</p> <p>In this case, Kirklees LLFA OBJECT to this planning application and request FURTHER INFORMATION is provided on the management of surface water on site. The level of detail given to this date is insufficient to make and informed decision and is insufficient compared to what is expected for a full planning application.</p> <p>Kirklees LLFA refer to their previous response, dated <u>21 November 2018</u>.</p>
