Hi I am writing this email with regards to the planning application 2018/93964 The Gables 5A Halifax road.

1, The entrance to the new development is in a very dangerous place, as people drive coming up the hill at ridiculous speeds (especially at the weekends when people around here seem to hire supercars and use it as a race track) and with cars turning into the new development all I can envisage are a lot of accidents due to the extra household traffic turning in and out of the entrance unless traffic calming measures or a different entrance is proposed.

2, I don't have dedicated parking spaces as the houses are Victorian on the road, I'm very mindful that should/when the work commences the builders and various trades shall be using the road, leaving us with nowhere to park... could there be some assurances that this would not be the case.

3, The heavy goods vehicles that use our road often also get stuck on the hill when heavily loaded, this may be a problem for the deliveries to the site and cause congestion on an already very busy road... ie 4-6 at a standstill most of the time.
