There is nowhere else for the children to play safely where we can see and hear them. The park at the top of Battye St is too far for them to go alone and is usually dominated by teenagers. When they play out here we can all look out for them and make sure they are all safe.

Another big issue is the amount of traffic/cars that a car park would bring to the area. This is such a small Cul-de-sac, we have very little traffic in and out. We very much want to keep it that way. If there is a car park made here, regardless where the entrance is, it is going to massively increase the amount of traffic on Battye St and cars in and out of our Cul-de-sac, turning round outside of our houses etc. Obviously this is the last thing any of us want, some of the residents here are
