As has been previously mentioned the damage it would cause to the community and wildlife would be disastrous. What does 'Greenbelt' mean to Kirklees council if they proceed with this? Clearly nothing! There are numerous other better suited sites that are available- Gomersal first school/ land owned by Tesco. Cliffe Lane struggles with traffic flow as it is without adding more pressure- the number of times the wall has been damaged on the corner evidences the increased dangers the project would present.
