Please can I object strongly to this planning application.

Firstly I object to building on green belt land when there are many other surrounding areas that could be converted into housing estates.

This development is planned on land which acts as a soakaway for rainwater from the above hills. Building on this land will lead to further flooding which has occurred here in the past. There would also be increased pressure on the villages ageing sewerage and drainage pipes which gives more risk of flooding.

It would also cause problems to highway safety as the development leads onto Barnsley Road which is a straight fast road and would in turn cause extra traffic to existing local roads. The main roads into and out of Denby Dale are already clogged up and at rush hours at a standstill.

Further developments will only cause more problems. There is currently not enough parking in Denby Dale and this development would put extra strain onto this village with increased traffic also putting children and pedestrians at risk of accidents.

Currently schools, doctors and dentists are working at full capacity and would not be able to cope with increased volume levels.
